Waste Categorization Audit

Our waste audits allow schools to gather accurate information about the types, amounts and weight of the waste being thrown out. This will help you identify the areas where you can make the biggest reductions.

The audit collects, weighs and sorts a full week's worth of waste into specific waste categories. The most common categories schools generate are paper/cardboard, food scraps, plastics and non-recyclable packaging. Once the waste streams have been separated, they are all weighed. Determining these weights (or volume in the case of non-recyclable packing as it is usually quite light), will help establish the quantity and types of recycling systems your school could set up.
